

## APRIL EXCO MEETING NEWS

### New Mission Statement

A brainstorming session examining the assets and challenges of IFSHT developed our new mission statement: *"To provide global networking and educational opportunities to develop and enhance the practice of hand therapy."* All discussions and decisions at the EXCO meeting were in support of this statement.

### Communication

IFSHT communicates through e-mail, our website, the News Flash twice a year, and this *IFSHT Update*, which is published in both the American and British *Journals of Hand Therapy* and sent to all Member Delegates.

Currently all communication is in English which excludes many hand therapists. In an effort to reach more therapists, IFSHT will initially seek a translator for the Spanish speaking members.

The website format is changing to be more user friendly, allowing easier updates of society information. A new area of the website will house IFSHT official documents and EXCO communication.

### Finances

IFSHT as a global organization cannot survive on membership dues alone. To assure the future of IFSHT, a profit sharing formula has been submitted to IFSSH for the IFSHT share of joint congresses. EXCO will also initiate a dialogue with our commercial members to evaluate our ongoing relationship.

### Membership

A new membership category of correspond-

ing member was discussed (for regional Hand Therapy Societies) and will be recommended at the 2010 Triennial Congress. To identify potential new members, IFSHT will endeavor to correspond with therapists in countries who have IFSSH membership but do not yet belong to IFSHT.

### APFSHT MEETS IN HONG KONG

Approximately 75 therapists attended the 3rd Congress of the Asian Pacific Federation of Societies for Hand Therapists (APFSHT) in Hong Kong on February 14-16, 2008. Countries represented were Australia, Hong Kong, Japan, Korea, Mainland China, Singapore, Sri Lanka, and Taiwan. The congress, hosted by the Hong Kong Society for Hand Therapy, was held at the waterside Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Center concurrently with the 7th Congress of the Asian Pacific Federation of Societies for Surgery of the
